

TOWN OF WEST TISBURY - BY-LAWS ADOPTED AT  
TOWN MEETING

QUORUM, TOWN MEETINGS  
STM JANUARY 17, 2006

At any meeting of the inhabitants of the town qualified to vote in town affairs, the number of voters necessary to constitute a quorum shall consist of not less than five percent (5%) of registered voters of the town at the time of said meeting, but a number less than a quorum may from time to time adjourn such meetings. This by-law shall not apply to meetings or parts of meetings devoted exclusively to the election of town officers.
