LANDFILL/REFUSE DISTRICT: The Agent and Board discussed Joan Ames' returnable Recycling question and agreed that David and Erik should bring it up for discussion At the next district meeting. A long discussion followed on the monthly LDO numbers. The new way the District bills for pick up of recyclables and the offset to the contract need to be monitored.

OLD/NEW BUSINESS: Fiddlehead Farm variance request was withdrawn, Borr 11-69 paid \$100 for open burning, Vineyard gardens has completed its storm water run-off work and a letter certifying it was received by Kent Healy. Sweeney 29-40 wants a variance to go on the property to do work. The Board will send a letter. The Agent reported to the Board that there was a case of West Nile reported on MV, but that it was most likely contracted in Missouri, the victim's home State. The Agent gave the Board the form for his evaluation, and the Agent's request for vacation carry-over. The first Flu Advisory was received, and the Agent reminded the Board that WT has purchased vaccine for a clinic the first week of November.

BEACH SAMPLING: The Agent reported that the swimming season being over, testing has Stopped with the exception of Seth's Pond which will be tested as long as the weather Holds. Other water tests for the school and town hall are proceeding with ½ completed.

PERMITS: The Agent reported on the food safety of service during the Artisans' labor Day event, And the Lippenzaner horse show. The Board signed a waste hauler permit for Blue Water.
