LANDFILL/REFUSE DISTRICT: The district is studying the question of redeeming returnables, The LDO coupon question is not yet decided, Monthly LDO numbers confirm the trend that costs are up due to the new billing regimen, with most of the proposed savings used in the first 3 months.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT: Flu advisory #2 received (no changes), the Agent updated the Board on the flu clinic. The VNS has confirmed 6 nurses for the clinic. The West Tisbury BOH share of the clinic cost will be approximately \$1,650.

OLD/NEW BUSINESS: Sweeney 29-40 is out of the house, and the house is still posted, A Town Hall water sample contained some coliform and the system was chlorinated. The Agent must now complete a more frequent testing of this public water supply for a month. 13 floor drains on a plumbing app for 6-2 were denied by DEP to tie into the septic. They may tie into a tight tank. There is no update on the Bernier's Market dumpster, Erik Lowe completed the Agent's evaluation, Dr. Breese, a vet, would like to rent space at 32-78 for a veterinary business with limited office calls. He is primarily a farm vet, but would have a single holding cage in the office. Planning Board minutes were reviewed confirming the need to redirect storm water runoff from Cronigs to the Carbo property. There will be a ZBA rooster hearing on 10/17 at 7:15. The Agent received an update from Janet on the Tennis Center pool at 31-70.7. Lowe 17-93 got approval to add a bedroom to a previously approved 6 bedroom system. The Agent discussed Hilton's DWA and it was decided that the system be inspected again to approve or not a 3rd bedroom on the system. If ok the room could go with existing garage hookup or in a main house addition if the garage hookup is decommissioned.

PERMITS: The Board signed a massage permit.
