

## **BOARD OF HEALTH MEETING MINUTES, MARCH 6, 2008**

**Present:** David Merry, Erik Lowe, Tim Barnett, Agent John Powers, and asst. Hadden Blair

**Wells Approved:** Vineyard Gardens 16-103 (because this property is in the Greenlands (aquifer) Protection Overlay District, and because the BOH is working to establish commercial & large system water use database, the Board is asking for metering of this irrigation well.) Patricia White 6-2 (three separate geothermal wells. The Board decided to require metering of these open end system wells which are expected to use significant gallonage)

**DWAs Approved:** Richard Baxter 21-14.1, Ralph Schlosstein 14-15, and John Pavlik 21-13.5 (This is a revised design for a Vet office. The Board decided to require metering as required at other Vet offices in town, and sent a letter to 21-13.5 noting the requirement)

**DWAs Held:** Gerald Ferry 1-33 (pending Con-Com)

**DWA Plan Reviews:** Richard Dubin 1-33 9Pending Con-Com), Barbara Beal 10-137 (variances are needed)

**Title 5 Inspection Reports Filed:** Clarence Barnes 16-68 (report incomplete, letter will be sent), MVI Realty, LLC 16-99.

**Landfill/Refuse District:** The Agent reported a hole near the LDO retaining wall. He and Mr. Merry will excavate and fill. Also, the fence near the residential side needs to be planted for screening.

**Emergency Management:** There will be a Coalition MRC meeting with new coordinator, Linda Costa on the 19<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> to create a plan and to start recruiting. The Agent gave a flu Update which indicates MA has peaked.

**Old/New Business:** Affordable Housing Proposal 10-199.8 is awaiting Planning Board approval. Buhda Path 37-37 wants to add a bathroom for their meditation center. Karelekas 7-104 has been in touch about recording his landfill area on his deed, Gadowski 26-13.1 neighbor's chicken trespass complaints had been quiet until this morning when ducks trespassed. The neighbor will try and solve this with Richard Andre. ZBA hearing next week for 7-143, the Agent discussed creating a revolving fund for Health Services line item for flu vaccine. By roster billing, the BOH will get \$ beyond expenditures to put back in Budget for purchasing vaccine going forward. VNA wants to bid this year on the health services contract. The Airport Commission renewed their Groundwater Discharge Permit for their 37,500 gallon/day treatment facility as required every 5 years. Saunders Associates sent a report indicating 16-222 is now clean, with no pollutants found in wells near the oil spill. The Board approved minutes from previous meetings.
