Wells Denied: The proposed irrigation well for Levy-Hinte 22-21.2 was denied the location is on an abutting lot and would need a deeded easement.

DWA APPROVED: Gary Rome 10-17, Richard Andre 31-16 (revision), Michael Baumrin 12-33 (revision) and Katherine Upson 31-111 (detached one bedroom/garage) and Iya Labunka 23-7.

DWA Denied: Estate of Leonard Athearn 31-68 (needs to show future well site on plans).

DWA Plan Review Denied: Richard Dubin 1-33 (System moved to location where soils changed perc rate).

Title 5 Reports: The revised report for Alvin Mentzel 31-3 was filed. The report for Pebco, LLC was reviewed and needs a permit for repairing the d-box and lines.

Landfill/Refuse District: Batteries for solar cash register have died and will be replaced this coming week. David signed the invoice for the batteries. Erik agreed to look into purchasing a new heater for the Shed. The Board voted to fine the septic pumpers for failing to require a permit from owners for pumping their septic system. The agent reminded the Board that revised plans for the drainage system for Chuck Wiley 16-103 have not been received yet. David reported that the drainage systems are not being maintained. John discussed the first meeting of the MVC wastewater steering committee where the group discussed a septage management plan for the Island. John is not sure that one plan fits all. John read a notice from the planning board regarding a hearing for an affordable proposal for 31-121. A letter was received from George Szakacs 30-2.63 agreeing to install an alternative septic system for a seven bedroom house with an existing six bedroom septic system. John reported that the proposal for a wind turbine for Boyle 7-117 is located over an existing leaching system and the proposed reserve area. The proposal calls for 3' deep by 6' long concrete tie downs that would be on top of the infiltrators that are located 3' below grade. Title 5 does not allow for this type of structure to be built over the system.
