DWA's: Mary and Rebecca Cournoyer 16-233. The Plan for was discussed at some length with dentist Dr. Hugo D' Ambrasio and condo owner Janet Cournoyer. Dr. D'Ambrasio is concerned about the wastewater from the proposed leaching system will run into his basement and there will be E-Coli contamination in the basement. The system as designed will be located 22' (20' state minimum) from the Basement wall and will not require substantial setback variances. The Board feels that a 20' setback as required by Title 5 is adequate. The Board explained the Title 5 and Local codes, along with separation between wells and Leaching. The question of when was the last time the water was tested and Dr. D' Ambrosio had no idea if the well had ever been tested, the Board suggested the water be tested at least once a year to safe guard his patients. The Board had no formal application and took no action.

OLD/NEW BUSINESS: John updated the Board on Minner 1-23, Health Services review put off until next meeting. The Board received the acceptance of Nomination for consideration of the proposed Island wind district. The Board will write a letter of support for Island Health, Inc
