EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT: John reported that we have received additional doses of the seasonal flu vaccine and that all the people on the VNA list will be taken care at the town clinics. John reported that as of December 4<sup>th</sup> all Island schools have been offered vaccine for all students. Plans are in the works for doing the second shots to children less than 10 and offer vaccine to the doctors and hospital to do their second shots less than 10 years old and those 6 months to 5 years of age. In the next tier all teachers will be offered the vaccine. The Agents are working on plans for an H1N1 clinic open to the general public in the very near future.
