

WEST TISBURY HISTORIC DISTRICT COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

Date of Hearing: January 5, 2009

1st Hearing convened at 5:30 PM

Application by Mr. Morgan for a new second story window on the front façade of Mr. Luskin's house Map 31/Lot 21 was approved unanimously as submitted.

2nd hearing at 6 pm.

Application by Town for a cedar wood white painted fence as presented by Mr. Hearn representing the Town was approved unanimously with the condition that certain details must be signed off on when more detailed plans are submitted. At that time a certificate will be granted. The fence should match the fence in front of the Grange in all details except possibly the posts will not all be granite; Mr. Hearn will return with requested information on granite posts, end posts only, on each section of fence. We all approved of the fence sections in the color drawing by Bob Schwartz that Mr. Hearn submitted, but the actual plans he also presented did not match the drawing, particularly on the corner of State Road and Music Street, where a fence section shown in the drawing is nonexistent on the plans. We would prefer to see the corner fence shown in the Schwartz drawing to be part of the plans, and asked Mr. Hearn to investigate that possibility with Doug Hoehn. It would require reshaping the driveway a bit to make the curve similar to the curve on the other end.

The hearing was continued.

The meeting was adjourned.
