

**WEST TISBURY PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE  
MINUTES JULY 7, 2010**

Approval of minutes from previous meetings was postponed due to lack of a quorum.

Joe gave an update on summer happenings. All staff returned from last year except one who was replaced by Shelby Ferry. All guards were recertified in AED and CPR. Jesse and the guards cleaned the path and collected garbage from the lot. All fence posts that needed repair were replaced or reset. July 4<sup>th</sup> weekend was very busy but no unexpected incidents. The parking situation has gone smoothly. Water testing has produced only positive results.

There have been daily complaints about the height of the dune. Joe commented this brings up several concerns; nearly 50% of the patrons are elderly making it difficult to traverse. Rescue time is now increased, private property is now more accessible. He suggested it be cut as it has in the past. Peggy will speak to David Merry. Joe ordered two new wheels for the wheelchair. They will be in next week.
