Inspection Fees: Ernie Presented a list of proposed changes to inspection fees inspired by the new building code, which will necessitate more inspections per job. He also has changed a few types fees that suggested and tried when the fees were last changed, but don't seem to be working well, "small decks" for example. He said the new code does not go into full effect until January, but some people are using it already. The fees reflect in general the fees charged by the other towns, but are generally lower. Skipper asked if the fees were different for lots given under affordable housing. Ernie said no, but he would be willing to bring those to the BOS for consideration.

Heritage Trail: Elaine Weintraub told the Board there would be a dedication for the 5 WT women who went down south in the 60's to register voters and spent the night in jail for their efforts. The women were Nancy Smith, Nancy Whiting, Peg Lillianthal, Virginia Mazur and Polly Murphy. This will be the first Heritage Trail site in West Tisbury and will be located in front of the old Library on Music Street.
