**SELECTMENS MEETING**  
Wednesday, August 11, 2010, 4:00 p.m. – 4:37 p.m.

**Present:** Selectmen Richard Knabel, Skipper Manter, Jen Rand  
**Guests** Dan Rossi, E. Mendenhall, S. Silk, Megan Dooley

**Minutes:** *S. Manter motioned to approve the minutes of 7/21/10 with an amendment. R. Knabel seconded the motion. The vote on the motion was unanimous in favor.*

**Event Permit – Flying Elbows:** Jen explained that the request for the permit came in too late to be approved at a regular meeting as the BOS took a week off. She said she granted the permit and asked the Board for a retroactive approval.

*S. Manter motioned to retroactively approve the Flying Elbow's CD release party at the Grange. R. Knabel seconded the motion. The vote on the motion was unanimous in favor.*

**Rotary Club Bicycle Challenge:** *S. Manter motioned to approve the Rotary Club Bicycle Challenge on 10/2/10. R. Knabel seconded the motion. The vote on the motion was unanimous in favor.*

**Old County Road Intersection Improvements:** The Board discussed the draft letter to Mass Highway regarding the delineators and the grooves in the pavement where reflective markers were placed. The letter was sent asking Mass Highway to reconsider the placement of delineators and potentially go back to the original plan of having them placed only on the Tisbury side of the intersection.

*S. Manter motioned to sign the amended letter. R. Knabel seconded the motion. The vote on the motion was unanimous in favor.*

**Bailey Park Land Disposition Agreement:** Jen was asked to send to Habitat for Humanity for comments. It will be on the agenda for a vote on the 25<sup>th</sup> if ready.
