School Building Project: Richard said the Board of Selectmen felt there should be a building committee, with building experience, to oversee the work that was planned for the summer. He said he thought there should be at least three people appointed. Kathy noted this was different from a town building project where committees are all volunteers; in the school district the work was primarily done by staff, in this case Amy. Dr. Weiss said he felt it was, at this point, a good idea because he felt that without the additional people the School Committee would be blamed if anything went wrong with the repairs. He added that the work would be unlikely to stay on schedule with the need to create a new committee. Cindy said she thought it was important to stay on track with the work, so perhaps the School Committee could continue on schedule, and the Town would appoint three people to work with the School Committee once they were on board. Dr. Weiss said he felt that was a reasonable approach.

The School committee took a unanimous vote to ask the Board of Selectmen to appoint three people.

Amy then outlined the work to be done and the cost, which will be in the neighborhood of \$1.557 million.
